

**SOUTH CAROLINA EDUCATION LOTTERY®
OFFICIAL RULES FOR
CASH BONANZA BONUS 2009
SECOND-CHANCE PROMOTION**

A. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. The South Carolina Education Lottery (SCEL) will conduct the Cash Bonanza Bonus Second-Chance Promotion ("Promotion") under the rules provided in this document. Cash Bonanza Bonus is an instant win game (Game Number SC 351).

The Official Rules for the Cash Bonanza Bonus 2009 Second-Chance Promotion are comprised of: (1) Act 59 of 2001, as amended; (2) the regulations of the South Carolina Education Lottery Commission; (3) any other matters adopted by SCEL; (4) the material presented in this document; (5) the Drawing Procedures Cash Bonanza Bonus 2nd Chance Promotion (the "Drawing Procedures"), an agreement between SCEL and MDI Entertainment LLC (MDI) a wholly owned subsidiary of Scientific Games International (SGI); (6) the contract between SCEL, SGI, and MDI contained within the working papers for Game Number SC 351; and (7) any practices or procedures (either written or unwritten) utilized by SCEL. The items cited herein are incorporated by reference and are binding as if printed herein. Each item cited above shall have equal weight unless there is an inconsistency between or among the documents in which case the document listed first shall be controlling.

Amendments to these rules, including change of location or cancellation of the Promotion, may be made at any time without notice, but must be made in writing and signed by the Executive Director of SCEL, or her designee. 2. **BY SUBMITTING AN ENTRY, AN ENTRANT IS BOUND BY THE OFFICIAL RULES OF THIS PROMOTION.**
3. **SCEL WILL USE, WITHOUT LIMITATION, AN ENTRANT'S HOMETOWN, NAME, LIKENESS, AND/OR VOICE IN ANY PROMOTIONS, RESEARCH, MARKETING, PUBLICATIONS OR OTHER ADVERTISING MEDIA INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE SCEL WEBSITE WITHOUT COMPENSATION OR ADDITIONAL RELEASE.**
4. The odds of being selected (or not being selected) to win one (1) of the prizes: one (1) winner of one million (\$1,000,000.00) dollars; five (5) winners of fifty thousand (\$50,000.00) dollars; and one hundred (100) winners of one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars, all offered in this promotion depend upon the number of entries submitted for each of the drawings.

B. DRAWING DATE TO BE DETERMINED

One (1) second-chance draw will be conducted by MDI for the Promotion on behalf of SCEL on August 25, 2010. A winner is entitled to only one (1) prize.

C. HOW TO ENTER

1. To be eligible to enter the Cash Bonanza Bonus Second-Chance Promotion, an entrant **must be at least 18 years of age** and submit a "Qualified Entry."

2. A "Qualified Entry" must consist of one (1) non-winning \$10 Cash Bonanza Bonus 2009 (Game Number SC 351) instant ticket. Only the Cash Bonanza Bonus instant ticket referenced in this paragraph may be submitted and **NO OTHER SCEL TICKETS QUALIFY FOR THIS PROMOTION**. A Qualified Entry must be made according to these rules.

3. **MAIL IN Entries:**

- (a) Entrants must place a first-class postage stamp on the ticket back where indicated and mail the ticket to: **SCEL, 1855 E. Main Street, Suite 14, PMB 3, Spartanburg, SC 29307**, the address pre-printed on the ticket back. Failure to use the correct amount of postage will not result in disqualification if an entry is received by SCEL at the proper address.
- (b) Entrants must complete the back of each ticket with his or her name, address (including city, state and zip code) and signature. The entrant should also include his or her best contact telephone number(s).
- (c) If an entry does not have the entrant's signature, name, address (including city, state and zip code) or if it is illegible, as determined by MDI draw personnel, it will be disqualified.
- (d) Submitting a winning ticket will not disqualify an entry, but neither MDI nor SCEL assume any responsibility for the validation of a winning ticket and will not attempt to locate or retrieve a winning ticket submitted for this Promotion.
- (e) Entries submitted must be original qualifying tickets. SCEL will not accept a facsimile (copy, replica, duplicate, or reproduction) of a ticket under any circumstances.
- (f) The same individual may not win more than once in the draw, but different individuals residing at the same address are eligible to win in the draw subject to the terms and conditions of these rules and the Draw Procedures.
- (g) Any ticket, other than a \$10 Cash Bonanza Bonus 2009 instant ticket (Game Number SC 351), is ineligible for entry and will be disqualified. Entries for this Promotion that are:

- i. **HAND-DELIVERED TO ANY SCEL OFFICE WILL BE DISQUALIFIED;**
- ii. **MAILED OR DELIVERED TO ANY SCEL ADDRESS OTHER THAN THE SPECIFIC "CASH BONANZA BONUS PROMOTION" ADDRESS PRE-PRINTED ON THE TICKET BACK WILL BE DISQUALIFIED; or**
- iii. **MAILED IN AN ENVELOPE, BOX OR OTHER CONTAINER WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**

"Live" or winning Cash Bonanza Bonus instant tickets **SHOULD NOT** be mailed for entry in the Promotion. Live or winning Cash Bonanza Bonus instant tickets will not be disqualified from the Promotion solely because it is a winning ticket

SCEL assumes no responsibility for, and will not attempt to locate, verify receipt of or validate, a Qualified Entry ticket or any other ticket mailed to the address provided in this Promotion. **The risk of loss for the misdelivery, late delivery, improper postage or failure of delivery for any tickets mailed to SCEL remains with the entrant.**

4. ELECTRONIC REGISTRATION:

To be eligible to electronically enter the Promotion, an entrant **must be at least 18 years of age** and must submit certain information from qualified non-winning instant tickets via the Internet according to these rules:

(a) Entrants must go to www.sceducationlottery.com and click on the Cash Bonanza Bonus Promotion link. The link will forward the entrant to the Promotion webpage. On the Promotion webpage, click the **Register Here** link to begin registration.

(b) Entrants must complete all required information blocks including, but not limited to, his or her first and last name, telephone number, email address, street address (including city, state and zip code), and date of birth. The entrant should include his or her best contact telephone number(s). Members of the same household may submit qualified electronic entries.

(c) If an electronic entry does not have all the required information, the electronic entry will be disqualified. Once the electronic entry system accepts the required ticket information from a qualified non-winning instant ticket, that same ticket information will not be accepted a second time in any of draws in this Promotion.

(d) A ticket other than a \$10 Cash Bonanza Bonus 2009 (Game Number SC 351) instant ticket is ineligible for electronic entry into a drawing and will be disqualified. Promotion Internet (electronic) entries that:

- i. **FAIL TO PROVIDE THE REQUIRED INFORMATION WILL BE DISQUALIFIED; or**
- ii. **ARE SUBMITTED ELECTRONICALLY AFTER THE PROMOTION DEADLINE WILL BE DECLINED.**

The risk of loss for the electronic misdelivery, late delivery, or failure of receipt for ticket information entered electronically in the Promotion remains with the entrant, regardless of the cause of the failure of transmission.

D. CASH BONANZA BONUS SECOND-CHANCE PROMOTION DRAW SCHEDULE

Entries must be received by mail no later than the last routine daily mail pickup on the entry deadline. **Entries received after the deadline, once determined, will be discarded.** The draw date may be modified and the draw time may be established as deemed appropriate by the Director of Security or his designee without notice or amendment to these rules.

E. THE DRAW

1. MDI, as SCEL's designee, will draw entries ("Selected Entrants") pursuant to the Draw Procedures. Upon qualification as provided in F., the first Selected Entrant (qualified entry number

one as described in the Draw Procedures) will be awarded the one million (\$1,000,000.00) dollar prizes. The next five (5) Selected Entrants will be awarded one (1) fifty thousand (\$50,000.00) dollars prize each. The next one hundred (100) Selected Entrants will be awarded one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars each. Alternates will be selected and shall replace a Select Entrant selected pursuant to the Draw Procedures.

2. An entrant is not eligible to be selected more than once. If an entrant is drawn more than once in the same draw, only the first entry for that player will be considered a selected entry and be eligible to win a prize, assuming that both entries are complete. If the first entry drawn is not complete, the individual's next or subsequent entry drawn will be deemed a selected entry, assuming the subsequent entry is complete. Entries that are unsigned, incomplete, illegible or a ticket or tickets other than the \$10 Cash Bonanza Bonus (Game Number SC 351) above will be disqualified pursuant to the Draw Procedures.

3. MDI is the designated agent for SCEL for the Promotion draw and will be responsible for securing the entries upon receipt. Draw Procedures are on file at SCEL and MDI. Complete details of the Draw Procedures are available on the SCEL website.

F. QUALIFICATION AND VALIDATION

Qualification(s)

1. If an entry selected is deemed ineligible or disqualified under any of these rules, that Selected Entrant will be replaced by the first or next available Alternate(s) from the draw.
2. SCEL staff will mail (certified return receipt requested, overnight delivery or other similar service that tracks delivery) or email a claim form to the winners selected based on the information submitted by the entrant selected as a prizewinner. The prizewinner must complete a claim form and provide all information necessary to process the claim. The designated SCEL Claims Center must receive the completed claim form with all information requested by SCEL by close of business on the date and time requested by SCEL. If the completed claim form and other information requested are not received by the date and time requested, the winner will be disqualified and replaced with an Alternate in the order drawn pursuant to the MDI Draw Procedures. SCEL assumes no responsibility for incorrect addresses, misdelivery, late delivery, or failure of delivery for any reason for any item(s) sent pursuant to this paragraph by either SCEL or the finalist, regardless of fault. **All risk of loss remains with and is assumed by the prizewinner.**
3. The name and signature submitted on the claim form must match the name and signature on the ticket(s) in the Qualified Entry. Similarly, the name and other contact information submitted on the claim form must match the name and other contact information provided when submitting electronic entries. If different individuals are submitted on the entry and the claim form, both individuals are subject to disqualification.
4. The entry and information submitted on the claim form are subject to additional validation and verification of eligibility by SCEL. The Selected Entrant is subject to disqualification if eligibility requirements are not met.

Additional Qualification and Validation Requirements

5. SCEL assumes no responsibility regarding an entry for misdelivery, late delivery, improper postage, or failure of delivery for any other reason, regardless of fault.

6. At the sole discretion of SCEL, disqualification of an entry may occur at the time an entry is received or at a later time, as provided in these rules.
7. SCEL employees, Intralot USA employees or family members residing in the household of those employees, MDI employees or family member residing in the household of those employees, or SGI employees or family members residing in the household of those employees or any other person ineligible to purchase South Carolina lottery tickets pursuant to Title 59, Chapter 150 of the South Carolina Code of Laws are ineligible to enter this promotion. Auditors who routinely perform work for SCEL and advertising firm employees who performed work for the Cash Bonanza Bonus 2009 Second-Chance Promotion are ineligible to enter this promotion.
8. Validity of entries, qualification of winners, drawing and awarding of prizes are subject to the policies, rules and regulations of SCEL and the laws of the State of South Carolina, including but not limited to, set off of certain debts in accordance with S.C. Code Ann. § 59-150-330.
9. **A SELECTED ENTRANT CHOSEN TO WIN A CASH PRIZE ASSUMES THE RISK OF LOSS AND IS SUBJECT TO DISQUALIFICATION IF:**
 - (a) **SCEL IS UNABLE TO CONTACT THE SELECTED ENTRANT;**
 - (b) **INFORMATION IS NOT TIMELY RECEIVED AS SPECIFIED; OR**
 - (c) **ANY OTHER REQUIREMENT IN THESE RULES IS NOT MET.**
11. A DECISION BY SCEL TO PROCEED TO NOTIFICATION AND QUALIFICATION OF AN ALTERNATE IS WITHIN THE SOLE DISCRETION AND JUDGMENT OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OR HER DESIGNEE. THE DECISION OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, IS EFFECTIVE UPON THE TIME AND DATE THE WRITTEN DETERMINATION IS MADE TO PROCEED WITH AN ALTERNATE AND MAY NOT BE RESCINDED. ONCE THE DECISION TO PROCEED WITH AN ALTERNATE IS MADE, THE PERSON WHO WAS PREVIOUSLY SELECTED IS NO LONGER ENTITLED TO THAT PRIZE AND IS NOT ENTITLED TO RELIEF OTHER THAN THAT SPECIFIED IN SECTION G.

G. MISCELLANEOUS

1. SCEL reserves the right to use the names, addresses and telephone numbers of all entrants for research and marketing purposes.
2. A decision relating to cancellation of the Promotion, amendment to the rules, the timing between draws, legibility of an entry, effort to notify a selected entrant, destruction of entries or a determination as to whether there is a duplicate entry are deemed not to be a cause for grievance relating to this promotion. A decision to alter the number of winners, for whatever reason, with or without notice, shall not constitute grounds for a grievance. Failure of delivery or misdelivery of an entry is not subject to a grievance proceeding and SCEL assumes no liability whatsoever for that occurrence regardless of fault.
3. By accepting a prize, each winner, his or her respective heirs, legal representatives, and assigns, agree to indemnify, defend, release and discharge the South Carolina Education Lottery, its employees, officers and directors from and against any loss, claim, damage, suit or injury arising out of or relating to this promotion or any action taken pursuant to the rules.
4. By entering for a chance to win a prize in the Promotion, the winner indemnifies, releases, discharges and agrees to hold harmless SCEL, its employees, officers and directors from

unanticipated cancellation, suspension or postponement of the Promotion due to natural disaster, national emergency, or other unforeseen act of God or man.

5. SCEL's total liability, for any activity taken pursuant to these rules, shall be limited to the purchase price of the ticket. Under any circumstances, regardless of the number of entries submitted or alleged to have been submitted, SCEL's total liability shall not be more than \$100.00 to a person who is found to be aggrieved by any aspect of this promotion or any application or any interpretations of the Official Rules.
6. Any person claiming to be aggrieved must file a written notice with the SCEL Executive Director, P.O. Box 11949, Columbia, SC 29211-1949, specifying the grounds for the grievance. Any grievance filed more than fifteen (15) days after the conclusion of this promotion will be deemed untimely. The filing of a grievance does not compel the Executive Director or her designee to delay any aspect of this promotion or payment of any prize.
7. In the event of any circumstances or interpretations of any matter whether contemplated or not contemplated in these rules, the interpretation and decision of SCEL's Executive Director, or her designee, will be final as provided by law.
