

**SOUTH CAROLINA EDUCATION LOTTERY™
AMENDMENT TO THE OFFICIAL RULES FOR
THE CAROLINA POWER DEAL PROMOTION**

A. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. The South Carolina Education Lottery (SCEL) will conduct the Carolina Power Deal Promotion ("Promotion") under the rules provided in the Official Rules for Carolina Power Deal Promotion executed on June 30, 2006 by the SCEL Executive Director. The Promotion will result in fifty-two (52) Carolina Power Deal drawings, but is ending one month early.

These amendments to the Official Rules of the Promotion made pursuant paragraph (A)(1) of the Official Rules.

B. CONTESTANT DRAW SCHEDULE AMENDED

1. The final entry deadline is changed from Friday July 13, 2007, to Friday June 15, 2007, and the final anticipated draw date is changed from Wednesday July 16, 2007, to Monday June 18, 2007. Registration forms (entries) received after the June 15, 2007 deadline for the final draw will be discarded.

Entries for the final draw must be received by mail no later than the last daily routine mail pickup on June 15, 2007.

2. **Registration Form Ending Date** Monday, June 11, 2007
3. **Final Entry Deadline** Friday, June 15, 2007
4. **Anticipated Final Draw Date** Monday, June 18, 2007
5. The final drawing will be conducted by SCEL Security personnel in accordance with the Official Rules of the Promotion.
6. All other particulars described in the Official Rules of the Promotion, including the prizes for participation on the Carolina Power Deal Show, entry qualifications, the qualification of contestants, the conducting of the Carolina Power Deal Show, and other miscellaneous sections all remain valid and apply.

**SOUTH CAROLINA EDUCATION LOTTERY™
OFFICIAL RULES FOR
CAROLINA POWER DEAL PROMOTION**

A. GENERAL PROVISIONS

2. The South Carolina Education Lottery (SCEL) will conduct the Carolina Power Deal Promotion ("Promotion") under the rules provided in this document. The Carolina Power Deal Game Show ("Show") is a Powerball® promotion. This promotion is scheduled to result in fifty-two (52) Carolina Power Deal drawings but may be ended

The Official Rules for the Promotion are comprised of: (1) Act 59 of 2001, as amended; (2) the regulations of the South Carolina Education Lottery Commission; (3) any other matters approved or adopted by SCEL; (4) the material presented in this document; and (5) any practices or procedures, written or unwritten, utilized by SCEL. The items cited herein are incorporated by reference and are binding as if printed herein. Each document cited above shall have equal weight unless there is an inconsistency or ambiguity between or among the documents, in which case the document listed first shall be controlling.

Amendments to these rules, including cancellation of the Promotion, may be made at any time without notice, but must be made in writing and signed by the Executive Director of SCEL. 3. **BY SUBMITTING AN ENTRY, AN ENTRANT IS BOUND BY THE OFFICIAL RULES OF THIS PROMOTION.**
4. **SCEL MAY USE AN ENTRANT'S HOMETOWN, NAME, LIKENESS, AND/OR VOICE IN SCEL PROMOTIONS, PUBLICATIONS OR OTHER ADVERTISING MEDIA INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE SCEL WEBSITE WITHOUT COMPENSATION OR ADDITIONAL RELEASE. THIS AUTHORIZATION IS NOT SUBJECT TO REVOCATION.**
5. The odds of being selected or not being selected in any draw of this promotion depends upon the number of entries submitted for each drawing.

B. PRIZE FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE CAROLINA POWER DEAL GAME SHOW

1. An entrant will be selected to be a contestant in one (1) segment of the Show as provided in these rules.

An entrant who qualifies to compete as a contestant on the Show will receive a prize with a minimum value of two thousand and no/100s (\$2,000.00) dollars. Depending upon the success of the contestant's selection(s) in the play of the Show, his or her final prize amount may be increased up to a maximum of twenty thousand and no/100s (\$20,000.00) dollars. Regardless of the amount, applicable federal (25%) and state (7%) income tax withholdings will be deducted from the gross winnings as required by law. A winner's ultimate tax liability will depend exclusively upon the winner's other personal income and deductions.

C. HOW TO ENTER

1. To be eligible to enter the Promotion, an entrant **must be at least 18 years of age** and submit a Promotion qualified entry form according to these rules:
 - a) A “qualified entry form” in the Promotion is an original form that is issued to a player during the Promotion period for each PURCHASE OF FIVE \$1 POWERBALL® PLAYS **AND** FIVE \$1 POWER PLAYS® ON ONE TICKET WHICH TOTALS TEN DOLLARS (\$10). A QUALIFIED ENTRY FORM IS ISSUED ON A “PER TICKET” BASIS BASED ON A QUALIFYING PURCHASE.
 - i. FOR MULTIPLE PLAY SLIP PLAYS FOR THE SAME DRAW, THE TERMINAL WILL PRINT AN ENTRY FORM FOR EACH TICKET GENERATED THAT SHOWS FIVE POWERBALL® PLAYS WITH FIVE POWER PLAYS®.
 - ii. FOR MULTIPLE QUICK PICK PLAYS FOR THE SAME DRAW, THE TERMINAL WILL PRINT AN ENTRY FORM FOR EACH TICKET GENERATED THAT SHOWS FIVE POWERBALL® PLAYS WITH FIVE POWER PLAYS®.
 - iii. **FOR MULTI-DRAW PLAYS (DRAWS OTHER THAN THE CURRENT DRAW) THAT CONTAIN FIVE POWERBALL® PLAYS AND FIVE POWER PLAYS® ON A SINGLE TICKET, THE TERMINAL WILL GENERATE ONLY ONE ENTRY FORM REGARDLESS OF THE NUMBER OF FUTURE DRAW PLAYS. GENERATING AN ADDITIONAL QUALIFYING ENTRY FORM REQUIRES PURCHASING A SEPARATE QUALIFYING TICKET.**
 - b) ALL ENTRIES SUBMITTED TO SCEL MUST BE ORIGINAL ENTRIES PRINTED ON OFFICIAL SCEL TERMINAL PAPER STOCK; SCEL WILL NOT ACCEPT A FACSIMILE (COPY, REPLIC, DUPLICATE, REPRODUCTION) OF AN ENTRY FORM.
 - c) The risk of loss if a qualified entry form fails to print following a qualifying purchase, for any reason whatsoever, remains with the purchaser. The purchaser is responsible for ensuring he or she receives the qualified entry form after a qualifying PowerBall® AND Power Play purchase. SCEL is not liable to the purchaser if a retailer fails to provide the form. An entry form not meeting the specifications of those rules will be disqualified.
 - d) Participants must complete a “qualified entry form” with his or her name, address (including city, state and zip code) and signature. Participants should also include his or her best contact telephone number or numbers. If an entry does not have the participant’s signature, name, address (including city and state) or if it is illegible, as determined by SCEL Security Personnel, it will be disqualified. An ENTRY **MUST** be in an envelope no larger than (7½ x 10½ inches). One entry per envelope. Envelopes containing more than one qualified entry form will not be disqualified but multiple entries in the same envelope will not enhance the entrant’s chances of winning. e) Promotion entries that are:

- i. HAND-DELIVERED TO ANY SCEL OFFICE WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
- ii. MAILED TO ANY SCEL ADDRESS OTHER THAN THE SPECIFIC Carolina Power Deal PROMOTION ADDRESS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
- iii. MAILED IN A BOX OR IN AN ENVELOPE WITH DIMENSIONS OTHER THAN THOSE LISTED ABOVE WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
- iv. IN ENVELOPES CONTAINING ENTRY FORMS FROM MORE THAN ONE INDIVIDUAL WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.

2. A Powerball® ticket or tickets **SHOULD NOT** be mailed with a “qualified entry form” for the Promotion. The “qualified entry form” is separate from the Powerball® ticket. However, a “qualified entry form” that is mailed in with a Powerball® ticket will not be disqualified from the Promotion drawing solely because it is mailed in with a Powerball® ticket.

SCEL assumes no responsibility for and will not attempt to locate, verify or validate a Powerball® ticket or any other game ticket that is mailed to the address provided in this promotion (see Section C, paragraph 1, item e). “Qualified entry forms” mailed to the SCEL Claims Office address **WILL NOT** be eligible for this promotion and will be disqualified. The risk of loss for the misdelivery, late delivery, improper postage or failure of delivery for “qualified entry forms” mailed to SCEL remains with the entrant.

D. CONTESTANT DRAW SCHEDULE

7. Seven draws will be conducted and multiple contestants will be selected to appear on the Show as provided herein. Entries received before an entry deadline **will be eligible only for the upcoming draw**. Entries received after the schedule deadline will be eligible for the next draw. Tickets received after the entry deadline for the final draw will be discarded.

Entries for each draw must be received by mail no later than the last daily routine mail pickup on the entry deadline dates listed in the next paragraph.

9. Each drawing will be conducted by SCEL Security personnel under the supervision of an independent auditor who will audit the drawing and will certify that draw procedures were followed. The drawing will occur at SCEL headquarters at 1333 Main Street, Columbia, South

Carolina, 29201. The date, time and place of a draw are subject to change without notice or amendment to the Official Rules.

10. A member of the SCEL Security Department or its designated agent will be responsible for securing the entries upon delivery to SCEL and, at the appropriate time, transporting the entries from that location to the area where the draw is conducted. Entries received for the draw will be placed in a draw container by SCEL Security personnel and will be mixed thoroughly. However, if the number of entries exceeds the capacity of the draw container, the Director of SCEL Security, or his designee, reserves the discretion to divide the entries into numbered storage containers. A number of storage containers will then be randomly selected to adequately fill the draw container one time. The draw will be conducted and the remaining entries received for that draw, but not chosen, will be discarded.

E. QUALIFICATION OF CONTESTANTS

1. The number of contestants drawn in each draw will range between five (5) and nine (9), depending upon the taping schedule of the Show. At least five (5) alternates will be selected in a draw. Irrespective of the number of times an individual is selected as a contestant for a taping of a Show, he or she may only qualify to appear on one Show during this Promotion period which concludes with the July 13, 2007 draw. A person selected more than once will be disqualified and will not be entitled to any prize resulting from the subsequent selection.
2. Disqualification of an entry for any reason not relating to the entry form or information on the form may occur at the time an entry is received or, as provided in these rules, at any time. Entries that are unsigned, incomplete, illegible or otherwise ineligible will be disqualified by SCEL Security personnel at the time the entry is drawn or at the conclusion of the entire draw. If needed, an alternate shall replace a disqualified entry in the order that the alternates were drawn. After the Contestants have been selected based on the qualifying criteria, all remaining alternates and unselected tickets from that drawing may be destroyed.
3. Based on the information provided by the entrant, SCEL staff will mail (certified return receipt requested or overnight delivery or other similar service that tracks delivery) a claim form to each of the contestants selected. A contestant must complete the claim form and provide all information necessary to process the claim. The claim form must be returned to the SCEL Claims Office in Columbia within the time specified by SCEL or the contestant will be disqualified and replaced with an alternate. If a notification letter is returned to SCEL or is otherwise undeliverable, the entry is subject to disqualification. **If a disqualification occurs at this point, the slot will be filled with an alternate.**
4. The name and signature submitted on the claim form must match the name and signature on the entry. If different individuals are submitted on the entry and the claim form, both individuals are subject to disqualification.
5. The entry and information submitted on the claim form of each contestant is subject to additional validation and verification of eligibility by SCEL and a contestant is subject to disqualification if eligibility requirements are not met. A contestant disqualified under any of these rules after the drawing will be replaced with an alternate.
6. **A CONTESTANT (OR ALTERNATE) ASSUMES THE RISK OF LOSS AND IS SUBJECT TO DISQUALIFICATION IF:**

(a) SCEL IS UNABLE TO CONTACT THE CONTESTANT;

(b) SCEL DOES NOT TIMELY RECEIVE INFORMATION FROM THE CONTESTANT AS SPECIFIED BY SCEL;

(c) ANY OTHER REQUIREMENT IN THESE RULES IS NOT MET; OR

(d) A DEADLINE OR REQUIREMENT IN THESE RULES OR ANY OTHER DEADLINE OR REQUIREMENT THAT MAY LATER BECOME NECESSARY IS NOT MET.

7. SCEL employees, Scientific Games employees or family members residing in the household of those employees or any other person ineligible to purchase South Carolina lottery tickets pursuant to Title 59, Chapter 150 of the South Carolina Code of Laws are ineligible to enter this promotion. Employees of the advertising firm or audit firm used for the Carolina Power Deal Promotion are ineligible to enter this promotion.
8. Validity of entries, qualification of winners, drawing and awarding of prizes are subject to the policies, rules and regulations of the SCEL and the laws of the State of South Carolina, including but not limited to, set off of certain debts in accordance with S.C. Code Ann. §59-150-330.

G. CAROLINA POWER DEAL SHOW

1. The rules of the Show will be issued as a supplement or addendum to the Promotion rules. The Show will be conducted under the supervision of SCEL Security personnel pursuant to procedures as may be determined by the Director of Security. Compliance with all rules and procedures must be certified by an independent auditor. If a foul is declared during the Show, the taping may be halted by the Director of Security or his designee. In its sole discretion, SCEL may end the selection process for that Contestant, resume the contest at the point of the foul, restart the process of selection from the beginning or take other action as deemed appropriate.
2. A Contestant is eligible to participate only in the taping schedule for which the Contestant was drawn. Multiple shows will be taped in one day (normally on a Saturday for the convenience of the Contestants) for broadcast at a later date. A Contestant who is unable to appear on that date may designate a proxy to appear in his or her place. If a Contestant is unable to appear as determined in the sole discretion of SCEL, a proxy or stand-in may be designated by SCEL. A proxy is not entitled to receive a prize or a portion of a prize awarded. SCEL assumes no responsibility for the selection or choices made by the proxy, irrespective of how the proxy was chosen.

H. MISCELLANEOUS

1. SCEL reserves the right to use the names, addresses and telephone numbers of all entrants for research and marketing purposes.
2. A decision relating to cancellation of the promotion, amendment to the rules, the timing between draws, legibility of an entry, effort to notify a selected entrant or contestant, destruction of entries or a determination whether there is a duplicate entry are deemed not to be subject to a grievance under these rules. A decision to alter the number of drawings or the number of contestants to be selected for a scheduled Show taping, for whatever reason, with or without notice, shall not constitute grounds for a grievance. The calling of a foul or any other action taken by SCEL Security Personnel or SCEL agents shall not constitute grounds for a grievance.

3. Failure of delivery or misdelivery of an entry is not subject to a grievance proceeding and SCEL assumes no liability whatsoever for that occurrence regardless of fault.
4. By agreeing to appear on Carolina Power Deal and participate in the show, each winner, his or her respective heirs, legal representatives, and assigns, agree to indemnify, defend, release and discharge the South Carolina Education Lottery, its employees, officers and directors from and against any loss, claim, damage, suit or injury arising out of or relating to this promotion or any action taken pursuant to the rules.
5. By agreeing to appear on Carolina Power Deal and participate in the show, the winner and his or her heirs, legal representatives, and assigns agree to indemnify, defend, release and discharge SCEL, its employees, officers and directors from and against any loss, claim, damage, suit or injury arising out of or relating to possession and any and all use of any and all winnings. Each Contestant may be required to sign an additional release prior to the award of the prize from Carolina Power Deal to the winner.
6. By entering for a chance to be a contestant on the Carolina Power Deal game show in this Promotion, a contestant indemnifies, releases, discharges and agrees to hold harmless SCEL, its employees, officers and directors from any loss resulting from or associated with the unanticipated cancellation, suspension or postponement of the promotion due to natural disaster, national emergency, or other unforeseen act of God or man.
7. SCEL's total liability, for any activity taken pursuant to these rules, shall be limited to the purchase price of the ticket. Under any circumstances, regardless of the number of entries submitted or alleged to have been submitted, SCEL's total liability shall not be more than \$50.00 to a person who is found to be aggrieved by any aspect of this Promotion or any application or any interpretations of the Official Rules.
8. Any person claiming to be aggrieved must file a written notice with the SCEL Executive Director, P.O. Box 11949, Columbia, SC 29211-1949 specifying the grounds for the grievance. Any grievance filed more than fifteen (15) days after the conclusion of this promotion will be deemed untimely. The filing of a grievance does not compel the Executive Director or his designee to delay any aspect of this promotion or payment of any prize.
9. In the event of any circumstances or interpretations of any matter whether contemplated or not contemplated in these rules, the interpretation and decision of SCEL's Executive Director, or his designee, will be final as provided by law.
