

SOUTH CAROLINA EDUCATION LOTTERY™
OFFICIAL RULES FOR
THAT'S THE TICKET Cash Bonanza Riches
SECOND CHANCE PROMOTION (Mail-In Entries Preliminary Draws)

A. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. The South Carolina Education Lottery (SCEL) will conduct the THAT'S THE TICKET Cash Bonanza Riches Second Chance Promotion mail-in preliminary drawings under the rules provided in this document. The Cash Bonanza Riches instant win lottery game is SCEL game number SC 200.

Amendments to these rules, including cancellation of the promotion, may be made at any time without notice, but must be made in writing and signed by the Executive Director of SCEL.

2. **BY SUBMITTING AN ENTRY, AN ENTRANT AGREES TO BE BOUND BY THE OFFICIAL RULES OF THIS PROMOTION.**
3. The odds of being selected or not being selected in any draw of this promotion depends upon the number of entries submitted for each drawing.

B. HOW TO ENTER

1. To be eligible to enter the THAT'S THE TICKET Cash Bonanza Riches Second Chance Promotion, an entrant **must be at least 18 years of age** and submit a non-winning \$10 Cash Bonanza Riches instant ticket according to these rules:
 - (a) Entrants must place a first class postage stamp (currently 41 cents) on the ticket back where indicated and mail the ticket to the address pre-printed on the ticket back. Failure to use the correct amount of postage will not result in disqualification if an entry is received by SCEL at the proper address.
 - (b) Entrants must complete the back of each ticket with his or her name, address (including city, state and zip code) and signature. The entrant should also include his or her best contact telephone number.
 - (c) If an entry does not have the entrant's signature, name, address (including city and state) or if it is illegible, as determined by SCEL Security personnel, it will be disqualified.

Any ticket other than a \$10 Cash Bonanza Riches instant ticket is ineligible for entry into a drawing and will be disqualified. THAT'S THE TICKET Cash Bonanza Riches entries that are:

- (i) **HAND-DELIVERED TO ANY SCEL OFFICE WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**
- (ii) **MAILED OR DELIVERED TO ANY SCEL ADDRESS OTHER THAN THE SPECIFIC "Cash Bonanza Riches" ADDRESS PRE-PRINTED ON THE TICKET BACK WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**

(iii) **MAILED IN AN ENVELOPE, BOX OR OTHER CONTAINER WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**

"Live" or winning Cash Bonanza Riches tickets **SHOULD NOT** be mailed for entry in the THAT'S THE TICKET Cash Bonanza Riches Second Chance Promotion. However, a live or winning Cash Bonanza Riches ticket will not be disqualified from the THAT'S THE TICKET Cash Bonanza Riches Second Chance Promotion solely because it is a winning ticket.

SCEL assumes no responsibility for and will not attempt to locate, verify receipt of or validate a Cash Bonanza Riches ticket or any other ticket mailed to the address provided in this promotion. **The risk of loss for the misdelivery, late delivery, improper postage or failure of delivery for any tickets mailed to SCEL remains with the entrant.**

C. PRELIMINARY DRAWS

1. Three (3) preliminary draws and three (3) grand prize draws will be conducted. Entries received before an entry deadline **will be eligible only for the upcoming preliminary draw.** Entries received after the preliminary draw deadline will be eligible for the next preliminary draw. Entries received on or after August 16, 2007, but before the deadline of the final preliminary drawing, will be eligible for the final, end-of-game preliminary draw. The entry deadline for the final preliminary draw is two weeks after the last day Cash Bonanza Riches tickets are authorized for sale as determined by SCEL. Tickets received after the entry deadline for the final preliminary draw will be discarded.

Entries for each preliminary draw must be received by mail no later than the last daily routine mail pickup on the entry deadline dates listed in the next paragraph.

Although the last date authorized for ticket sales has not been established at this time, it is anticipated that the Cash Bonanza Riches ticket sales will end before November of 2008.

3. Each preliminary drawing is scheduled to begin at 2:00 p.m. and will be conducted under the supervision of an independent auditor who will audit the drawing and will certify that draw procedures were followed. The drawing will occur at SCEL headquarters at 1333 Main Street, Columbia, South Carolina, 29201. The date, time and place of a draw are subject to change without notice or amendment to the Official Rules.
4. A member of the SCEL Security Department or its designated agent will be responsible for securing the entries upon delivery to SCEL and, at the appropriate time, transporting the entries from that location to the area where the draw is conducted. Entries received for the draw will be placed in a draw container by SCEL Security personnel and will be mixed thoroughly. However, if the number of entries exceeds the capacity of the draw container, the Director of SCEL Security, or his designee, reserves the discretion to divide the entries

into numbered storage containers. A number of storage containers will then be randomly selected to adequately fill the draw container one time. The draw will be conducted and the remaining entries received for that draw, but not chosen, will be discarded.

Selection Process

5. At each scheduled Preliminary drawing, SCEL Security personnel will draw four entries ("selected entries"), not including alternates and entries that may be disqualified during the selection process. Entries that are unsigned, incomplete, illegible or a ticket other than a \$10 Cash Bonanza Riches ticket will be disqualified by SCEL Security personnel at the time the entry is drawn or at the conclusion of the entire draw. At least ten (10) alternates shall be drawn and, as provided herein if needed, an alternate shall replace an illegible, incomplete, unsigned or duplicate entry in the order that the alternates were drawn (see paragraph 8). After the selected entries and at least ten (10) alternates are drawn based on the qualifying criteria in this paragraph, unselected tickets from that drawing may be destroyed.
6. Subject to applicable provisions of these rules, the first four (4) entries drawn in each preliminary drawing become entries in a Grand Prize drawing. Four (4) selected entries from the mail-in preliminary draws and four (4) selected entries from the electronic preliminary draws become the eight (8) finalists for each Grand Prize draw (see separate draw procedures).
7. Although an entrant is not eligible to be a selected entrant more than once in a scheduled draw, an entrant is eligible to enter and be selected in subsequent draws provided the entries meet the draw entry deadlines. If an entrant is drawn more than once in the same draw, only the first entry for that player will be considered a selected entry, assuming that both entries are complete. If the first entry drawn is not complete, the individual's next or subsequent entry drawn will be deemed a selected entry, assuming the subsequent entry is complete. Tickets submitted by mail are not eligible to be submitted by internet. If this occurs, both entries will be disqualified.
8. If an entrant selected is deemed to be invalid, ineligible or disqualified under any of the official rules and/or procedures, that selected entrant will be replaced by the alternate in the order drawn. That alternate will be notified and must meet all of the validation and eligibility requirements. In the event a first selected entrant is disqualified and replaced by an alternate, every other alternate shall each advance by one number in the order drawn. The last numbered alternate slot shall become unassigned.
