

**SOUTH CAROLINA EDUCATION LOTTERY™**  
**OFFICIAL RULES FOR**  
**THAT'S THE TICKET CASH BONANZA RICHES (SC 200)**  
**SECOND CHANCE PROMOTION**

**A. GENERAL PROVISIONS**

1. The South Carolina Education Lottery (SCEL) will conduct the That's The Ticket Second Chance Promotion ("Promotion") under the rules provided in this document. The Cash Bonanza Riches instant win lottery game is SCEL game number SC 200.

The Official Rules for the Promotion are comprised of: (1) Act 59 of 2001, as amended; (2) the regulations of the South Carolina Education Lottery Commission; (3) the material presented in this document; (4) the Draw Procedures as written or approved by SCEL; and (5) any other practices or procedures (either written or unwritten) utilized by SCEL. The items cited herein are incorporated by reference and binding as if printed herein. Each document cited above shall have equal weight unless there is an inconsistency between or among the documents, in which case the document listed first shall be controlling.

Amendments to these rules, including cancellation of the Promotion, may be made at any time without notice, but must be made in writing and signed by the Executive Director of SCEL.

2. **BY SUBMITTING AN ENTRY, THE ENTRANT IS BOUND BY THE OFFICIAL RULES OF THIS PROMOTION.**
3. **AN ENTRANT CONSENTS TO ALLOW SCEL, WITHOUT LIMITATION, TO USE HIS OR HER HOMETOWN, NAME, LIKENESS, AND/OR VOICE IN ANY PROMOTIONS, RESEARCH, MARKET, PUBLICATIONS OR OTHER ADVERTISING MEDIA INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE SCEL WEBSITE WITHOUT COMPENSATION OR ADDITIONAL RELEASE. THIS CONSENT IS NOT SUBJECT TO REVOCATION.**
4. The odds of being selected (or not being selected) in any draw of this Promotion depends upon the number of entries submitted for each drawing.

**B. PRIZES**

1. Nine (9) Second-Chance Grand Trip Prizes will be awarded in this Promotion. The Grand Trip ("Trip") includes a seven-day, six-night trip for two (2) persons to one of the following destinations: Los Angeles, California; New York City, New York; or Las Vegas, Nevada. The trip includes: a minimum of twenty-five thousand (\$25,000.00) dollars in cash; first class airfare (for the winner and his or her guest) from the airport nearest the winner's home (as determined by SCEL) served by a major U.S. air carrier; deluxe driver services for ground transfers between the airport and the hotel; and accommodations for two (2) persons in a deluxe (four or five star) hotel for six (6) nights; one (1) set of luggage (valued at approximately \$200); a digital camera (valued at approximately \$200); and one (1) iPod® Nano®.

The value of the Trip (approximately \$50,000) includes applicable federal (25%) and state (7%) income tax withholdings. The Trip winner's ultimate tax liability will depend exclusively upon the winner's other personal income and deductions. Federal and state withholding taxes will be paid by SCEL or its agent and a W2G tax form shall be provided to the winner.

The Trip does not include mileage, insurance, gratuities, meals or beverages, parking fees, departure fees, excess baggage fees, alcoholic beverages, any items not expressly specified or

personal expenses such as telephone calls (local or long distance), valet service, laundry service, and the like, or revision or cancellation fees that may be imposed by an airline, hotel or other third party supplier. Certain restrictions and limitations apply and the failure to book and complete the trip within one year of award may result in forfeiture of the prize or a portion of the prize. Reservations are contingent upon availability of each component of the Trip.

The Trip winner **may not** exchange the Trip for cash and SCEL **will not** pay a winner the cash value of the Trip except as provided herein. **The Trip may not be resold.** If a winner is unable to travel, the Executive Director must approve substitutions before any alternate reservations are booked. The decision as to whether to approve or deny assignment or substitution is within the sole discretion of the Executive Director and not subject to appeal. After the trip is booked, the risk of loss for any or all portions of the Trip rests solely with the winner. No person, other than the person for whom the claim is validated, has any right to any portion of the prize and the W2G will be issued only to the winner, irrespective of an authorization for substitution of a traveler. SCEL assumes no liability for payment of a prize or fulfillment of any portion of the Trip to anyone other than the claimant.

2. Eight (8) \$5,000 cash prizes will be awarded to semifinalists who do not win trip packages. The \$5,000 cash prize will be given away in the first two (2) second-chance drawings, four (4) cash prizes per draw, for an aggregate eight (8) cash prizes, pursuant to the Draw Procedures.

### C. TWO WAYS TO ENTER

1. **A single Cash Bonanza Riches ticket is valid for only one method of entry - either by mail or by electronic registration - for each draw date as specified hereinafter in Section D. If the same ticket information is contained on a ticket drawn from a mailed in entry and one entered electronically, both entries will be disqualified. The same person may not win a Grand Prize Trip or the \$5000 cash prize more than once.**
  - (a) "Live" or winning Cash Bonanza Riches tickets **SHOULD NOT** be mailed for entry in the Promotion. However, a live or winning Cash Bonanza Riches ticket that is mailed in will not be disqualified from the Promotion solely because it is a winning ticket.
  - (b) "Live" or winning Cash Bonanza Riches tickets **SHOULD NOT** be entered electronically in the Promotion. However, ticket information from a live or winning Cash Bonanza Riches ticket that is electronically entered will not be disqualified from the Promotion solely because it is a winning ticket.
2. **MAIL IN** - To be eligible to enter the Promotion, an entrant **must be at least 18 years of age** and must submit a non-winning \$10 Cash Bonanza Riches (Game SC 200) instant ticket according to these rules:
  - (a) Entrants must place a first class postage stamp on the ticket back where indicated and mail the ticket to the address pre-printed on the ticket back. SCEL will not accept any entry with postage due. However, failure to use the correct amount of postage will not result in disqualification if an entry is received by SCEL at the proper address.
  - (b) Entrants must complete the back of each ticket with his or her name, telephone number, address (including city, state and zip code) and signature. The entrant should include his or her best contact telephone number(s), as the deadlines for awarding the Grand Prize may be time sensitive.
  - (c) If an entry does not have the entrant's signature, name, telephone number, address (including city and state) or if it is illegible, as determined by the Draw Procedures, it will be disqualified.

A ticket other than a \$10 Cash Bonanza Riches instant ticket (game number SC 200) is ineligible for entry into a drawing and will be disqualified.

That's The Ticket Cash Bonanza Riches entries that are:

- i. **HAND-DELIVERED TO ANY SCEL OFFICE WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**
- ii. **MAILED OR DELIVERED TO ANY SCEL ADDRESS OTHER THAN THE SPECIFIC "THAT'S THE TICKET CASH BONANZA RICHES" ADDRESS PRE-PRINTED ON THE TICKET BACK WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**
- III. **MAILED IN AN ENVELOPE, BOX OR OTHER CONTAINER WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**

SCEL assumes no responsibility for and will not attempt to locate, verify receipt of, or validate a Cash Bonanza Riches ticket or any other ticket mailed to the address provided in this Promotion. **The risk of loss for the misdelivery, late delivery, improper postage or failure of receipt for any ticket(s) mailed in the Cash Bonanza Riches Second Chance Promotion remains with the entrant.**

3. **ELECTRONIC REGISTRATION** - To be eligible to electronically enter the Promotion, an entrant **must be at least 18 years of age** and must submit certain information from the front of a non-winning \$10 That's The Ticket Cash Bonanza Riches (Game SC 200) instant ticket via the Internet according to these rules:

- (a) Entrants must go to [www.sceducationlottery.com](http://www.sceducationlottery.com) and click on the That's The Ticket Cash Bonanza Riches link. The link will forward the entrant to the That's The Ticket Cash Bonanza Riches webpage. On the That's The Ticket Cash Bonanza Riches webpage, click the **Register Here** link to begin registration.
- (b) Entrants must complete all required information blocks including, but not limited to, his or her first and last name, telephone number, e-mail address, street address (including city, state and zip code) and date of birth. The entrant should include his or her best contact telephone number(s), as the deadlines for awarding the Grand Prize are very time sensitive.
- (c) If an electronic entry does not have all the required information or if the electronic entry duplicates a properly completed mailed in entry, as determined by the Draw Procedures, both entries will be disqualified. Once the electronic entry system accepts the required ticket information from a Cash Bonanza Riches ticket, the same ticket information will not be accepted a second time for the duration of the Promotion.

A ticket other than a \$10 (Game SC 200) instant ticket is ineligible for electronic entry into a drawing and will be disqualified. That's The Ticket Cash Bonanza Riches Internet (electronic) entries:

- i. **THAT FAIL TO PROVIDE THE REQUIRED INFORMATION WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**
- ii. **THAT ATTEMPTS TO SUBMIT ELECTRONIC ENTRIES AFTER THE FINAL DEADLINE WILL BE DECLINED.**

**The risk of loss for the electronic misdelivery, late delivery, or failure of receipt for ticket information entered electronically in the Promotion remains with the entrant, regardless of the cause of the failure of transmission.**

## D. SELECTION PROCESS

### TRIP PRIZE QUALIFYING DRAWINGS

1. Three (3) drawing events will be conducted to choose eight (8) "Finalists" who will participate in another selection process to win a Prize Trip. Each draw will consist of an electronic and manual component as provided herein.
2. Entries submitted by mail must be received no later than the entry deadline dates listed below in the last scheduled mail collection occurring during normal business hours on the date of the deadline, at a time as may be determined appropriate by SCEL. If submitted electronically, entries must be received no later than 11:59 p.m. on the entry deadline dates listed below.
3. Entries received before an entry deadline **will be eligible only for the upcoming draw**. Entries received after an entry deadline will be eligible for the next draw. Entries received after the final deadline will be discarded.

#### 4. Entry Deadline

5. Four (4) Prize Trips and four (4) cash prizes will be awarded in a live Promotional draw event (scheduled for Charleston, South Carolina on July 3, 2007) from the finalists selected in the June draw as presented below. Four (4) Prize Trips and four (4) cash prizes will be awarded in a live Promotional draw event (scheduled for Myrtle Beach, South Carolina on September 1, 2007) from the finalists selected in the August draw as presented below. One (1) Trip will be awarded in the final drawing held no later than thirty (30) days after the last day to sell the Cash Bonanza ticket.

### Selection of Finalists and Prize Winners

- 6 (a.) **Electronic.** On each electronic draw date, four (4) Finalists and ten (10) alternates will be randomly chosen from the electronic entries submitted by the respective draw deadline. Each draw will be conducted pursuant to the Draw Procedures under the supervision of an independent auditor, who will audit the drawing and will certify that the electronic Draw Procedures were followed. The electronic drawings will occur at the Offices of MDI, located at 1500 Bluegrass Lakes Parkway, Alpharetta, Georgia, 30004.

(b.) **Mail-In.** On each draw date, SCEL Security personnel will randomly choose four (4) Finalist and ten (10) alternates from the mailed entries submitted by the respective draw deadline. Entries received will be placed in a draw container by SCEL Security personnel and will be mixed thoroughly. However, if the number of entries exceeds the capacity of the draw container, the Director of SCEL Security, or his designee, reserves the discretion to divide the entries into numbered storage containers. Storage containers will be randomly selected to adequately fill the draw container one time. Entries that are unsigned, incomplete, or otherwise ineligible will be disqualified by SCEL Security personnel. The draw will be conducted and the remaining entries received for that draw, but not chosen, will be discarded.

7. Upon qualification of the Finalists as provided in Section E., the eight (8) Finalists selected in each of the first two draws are eligible to win one (1) of four (4) Prize trips or one of four (4) cash prizes of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) which will be selected and awarded at a SCEL Promotional draw event. The Finalists must be present at the respective Promotional draw event for which he or she was chosen; provided, however, that a Finalist may select a proxy to attend the drawing in his or her stead so long as the proxy is at least 18 years of age. If a finalist fails to select a proxy, SCEL will select a proxy for the Finalist. Any proxy, whether selected by the Finalist or by SCEL, will not be entitled to any prize or portion of any prize awarded during the Promotion.
8. The Promotional draw events will be conducted under the supervision of SCEL Security Personnel under rules and procedures as may be determined by the Director of Security. This may include a draw or other contest wherein the winners will be randomly chosen from among the eight (8) Finalists. If a foul is declared during the selection of the Prize Trip (and cash prizes), the selection process shall be halted and the Director of Security, or his designee, will void or reinstitute the process as he or she deems appropriate.
9. Upon qualification of the Finalists as provided in Section E., the eight (8) Finalists selected on the final draw date are eligible to win one ) Prize trip that will be selected in a random draw and awarded among those eight (8) finalists (no Promotional event will be held and no other prizes will provided) as directed by the SCEL Director.
10. The time for all drawings will be established without amendment to the rules. Both the place and time are subject to change without written notice.

#### **E. QUALIFICATION AND VALIDATION OF FINALISTS**

1. **An entrant may not qualify as a Finalist more than one time in this Promotion.**
2. SCEL employees, MDI and SGI employees, or family members residing in the household of those employees, or any other person ineligible to purchase South Carolina lottery tickets pursuant to Title 59, Chapter 150 of the South Carolina Code of Laws, are ineligible to enter this Promotion. Auditors who routinely perform work for SCEL and advertising firm employees who performed work for this Promotion are also ineligible to enter.
3. Disqualification of an entry may occur at the time an entry is received or at a later time as may appropriate or required by these rules.
4. Based on the information submitted, SCEL staff will send a claim form to each entrant selected as a Finalist by certified mail or a commercial overnight delivery service. The claim form must provide all information necessary to process the claim and must be returned within the timeframe called for in the notification. If the completed claim form and other information requested is not received by the required date, the Finalist will be disqualified and replaced with an Alternate in the order drawn pursuant to Paragraphs 6 and 7 of this section, as may be appropriate, depending upon whether the disqualified entrant was submitted electronically or by mail. SCEL assumes no responsibility for incorrect addresses, misdelivery, late delivery, failure of delivery for any reason for any item(s) sent pursuant to this paragraph by either SCEL or the Finalist, regardless of fault. All risk of loss remains with, and is assumed by, the Finalist.— Further:
  - (a) The name submitted on the claim form must match the name and signature on the Entry. If different individuals are submitted on the entry and the claim form, both individuals are subject to disqualification.

(b) The entry and information submitted on the claim form are subject to validation and verification of eligibility by SCEL as required by all claimants. The selected entrant (Finalist) is subject to disqualification if all eligibility requirements are not met.

5. If an entry ticket or electronic entry entrant selected to be a Finalist is deemed ineligible or disqualified under any of these rules, the Alternate must qualify to participate as a Finalist no later than the time specified by SCEL. The Alternate is subject to the same terms and conditions provided in Paragraph 3 of this section.

6. **AN ENTRANT SELECTED AS A FINALIST ASSUMES THE RISK OF LOSS AND IS SUBJECT TO DISQUALIFICATION IF:**

(a) **SCEL IS UNABLE TO CONTACT THE FINALIST;**

(b) **INFORMATION, AS SPECIFIED BY SCEL, IS NOT TIMELY RECEIVED FROM THE FINALIST; OR**

(c) **ANY OTHER REQUIREMENT UNDER THESE RULES IS NOT MET.**

7. A DECISION BY SCEL TO PROCEED TO NOTIFICATION AND QUALIFICATION OF AN ALTERNATE IS WITHIN THE SOLE DISCRETION AND JUDGMENT OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE. THE DECISION OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, IS EFFECTIVE UPON THE TIME AND DATE THE WRITTEN DETERMINATION IS MADE TO PROCEED WITH AN ALTERNATE AND MAY NOT BE RESCINDED. ONCE THE DECISION TO PROCEED WITH AN ALTERNATE IS MADE, THE PERSON WHO WAS PREVIOUSLY SELECTED IS NO LONGER ENTITLED TO THE GRAND PRIZE AND IS NOT ENTITLED TO RELIEF OTHER THAN THAT SPECIFIED IN SECTION F.

8. Validity of entries, qualification of winners, drawing and awarding of prizes are subject to the policies, rules and regulations of SCEL and the laws of the State of South Carolina, including, but not limited to, setoff of certain debts in accordance with S.C. Code Ann. § 59-150-330. A person who is entitled to a prize must satisfy any outstanding debt prior to the award of the remaining portion of the prize, if any. If a Trip Prize winner fails to satisfy an outstanding debt, SCEL, in its sole discretion, may elect to pay the cash value, less applicable federal (25%) and state (7%) income tax withholdings, in order to satisfy the winner's debt or reduce the cash portion of the prize amount. The winner may then dispute any amounts withheld pursuant to §59-150-330 of the South Carolina Code as may be authorized by law. Any portion of the disputed amount found to be invalid or any reduction in the amount owed due to a settlement with the claimant agency, will be remitted to the winner.

## **F. MISCELLANEOUS**

1. The guest of a Trip winner may also be requested to submit certain information necessary for flight or other arrangements as may be required to fulfill a Trip prize. It is the responsibility of the winner to provide the information necessary to arrange for his or her guest. Any and all risk of loss regarding the guest portion of the Trip remains with the winner, irrespective of who may be at fault for any incorrect information or any inability to participate in or receive any component of the Trip options. Age restrictions may apply to hotel registration. Any Trip modifications resulting from the age of a guest or winner must be resolved by the Executive Director or his designee.

2. By accepting the guest portion of the Trip, the guest indemnifies, releases, discharges and agrees to hold harmless SCEL, its employees, officers and directors from and against any loss,

claim, damage, suit or injury arising out of or relating to the use of or participation in any and all aspects of the Trip.

3. By accepting the Trip and participating in any activities and in any or all options that are a part of the Trip, including ground and/or air travel to and from the destination, the winner and his or her guest and their respective heirs, legal representatives, and assigns agree to indemnify, defend, release and discharge SCEL, its employees, officers and directors from and against any loss, claim, damage, suit or injury arising out of or relating to use of or participation in any or all aspects of the Trip. Each winner and guest will be required to sign a release form prior to the award of the Trip to the winner.
4. By accepting the Grand Prize Trip and completing travel to the destination, the winner indemnifies, releases, discharges and agrees to hold harmless SCEL, its employees, officers and directors from the unanticipated total cancellation or suspension or postponement of the scheduled shows or any of the accompanying events due to weather, natural disaster, national emergency, or other unforeseen act of God or man.
5. SCEL's total liability, for any activity taken pursuant to these rules, shall be limited to the purchase price of the ticket. Under any circumstances, regardless of the number of entries submitted or alleged to have been submitted, SCEL's total liability shall not be more than \$100.00 to a person who is found to be aggrieved by any aspect of this Promotion or any application or any interpretations of the Official Rules.
6. SCEL reserves the right to use the names, addresses and telephone numbers of all entrants for research and marketing purposes.
7. After the completion of a draw, all entries, including: disqualified entries; the entries not selected in that draw; and any unused alternates, will be retained or destroyed as directed by the Director of SCEL Security or his designee.
8. Any person claiming to be aggrieved must file a written notice with the SCEL Executive Director, P.O. Box 11949, Columbia, SC 29211-1949, specifying the grounds for the grievance. Any grievance filed more than fifteen (15) days after the conclusion of this Promotion will be deemed untimely.
9. The filing of a grievance does not compel the Executive Director or his designee to delay any aspect of this Promotion or payment of any prize.
10. In the event of any circumstances or interpretations of any matter, whether contemplated or not contemplated in these rules, the interpretation and decision of SCEL's Executive Director, or his designee, will be final as provided by law.
11. A decision relating to amending the rules, the timing of a draw, legibility of an entry, effort to notify a selected entrant, destruction of entries or a determination whether there is a duplicate entry are deemed not to be subject to a grievance under these rules. Failure of delivery or misdelivery of an entry is not subject to a grievance proceeding and SCEL assumes no liability whatsoever for that occurrence regardless of fault.
