SAMPLES

1. The bid due with samples on 9/7/2011 – Can those samples be blank samples of the product? Or do the samples need to be printed with your logo?

Answer: Each of the four (4) samples must be printed with sample logos; however, they do not need to be printed with the South Carolina Education Lottery's (SCEL) logo. A non-SCEL logo will be sufficient.

2. And, if we are all bidding on the same exact item, would you need a sample from each bidder?

Answer: Yes. A sample of each item is required to be sent in with each bid (from each vendor) in order to be considered for the award of the contract.

Item 2: TRAVEL MUGS

3. Travel Mug: Will the attached do as an equal?



Answer: No. The cup must be white and the lid and the rubber grip must both be red. No other colors will be acceptable.

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Item 3: LARGE INSULATED COOLERS

4. I have learned that currently there are only 2000 pieces (as of yesterday) of the #1013 in stock. The balance could be done overseas. That would require at least 65 – 75 days. Could that work for the lottery?

Answer: Yes. SCEL will accept a partial delivery for Item #1013 (2000 red coolers) now and the balance of Item #1013 (500 red coolers) in 65-75 days.

Item 4: FLEECE GLOVES

5. What part of the Fleece Glove is to be embroidered? The SM/M size has only a 1 ½ in. high area from the elastic wrist up and the L/XL has a 1 ¾ in. area.

Answer: The top of the wrist on the fleece glove of the right-hand must be imprinted with SCEL's logo. (Please note SCEL's embroidered logo measures less than 3 ¾"W x 1 ¼"H.)

6. I have been advised that the embroidery area of the glove is very small and more than likely could not accommodate the entire SCEL logo. Would you consider silk-screening? Please advise.

Answer: Bidders may submit a sample with a silk-screened logo imprinted on the top of the wrist on the fleece glove of the right hand if he/she is unable to provide an embroidered sample/bid as requested.

Note: if you are submitting a silk-screened sample, you must submit pricing for a silk-screened logo as well.

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7. On item 4. Fleece Gloves, will the SCEL logo be modified for embroidery? Our embroiderer has reviewed the logo and advised that the area on the glove is too small for the entire logo, they could do the tree, but the text would be too small in that area and not legible. They mentioned a digital heat transfer as an option to get the entire logo on the glove. Also, please confirm that both gloves are to be logoed.

Answer: SCEL's logo will not be modified for the embroidery. Bidders may submit a sample with a digital heat transfer (or a silk-screened logo) imprinted on the right-hand of the fleece glove if he/she is unable to provide an embroidered sample as requested. Note: if you are submitting a sample with a digital heat transfer (or a silk-screened sample), you must submit pricing for a digital heat transfer (or a silk-screened imprint) as well. To reiterate, only one glove is to be imprinted with SCEL's logo (the right-hand of the fleece glove only).

AWARD

8. Will this bid be awarded per item or one award for all items?

Answer: This bid will be awarded to one vendor for all four items.
