The solicitation for the SCEL FY22 Golf Pencil with NO ERASER RFQ, issued on December 6, 2021, has been cancelled prior to award in accordance with South Carolina Consolidated Procurement Code (“the Code”) State Procurement Regulations 19-445.2065 (B)(1)(h). SCEL originally solicited this written request for quotes with the intent to obtain a minimum of three written quotes from qualified sources of supply without advertising at least once in the South Carolina Business Opportunities publication pursuant to the small purchase procedures for commercially available off-the-shelf products not in excess of one-hundred thousand dollars in Section 11-35-1550(2)(b). The determination to cancel this bid is a result of SCEL not receiving responsive quotes from at least three responsible bidders pursuant to Regulation 19-445.2100 (B)(1)(2). *Notice of this Cancellation of Bid Prior to Award* is being sent electronically to the email address each Offeror provided when submitting a response to this solicitation.
