## REMINDERS

BY STATE LAW, ODDS INFORMATION MUST BE DISPLAYED IN ALL RETAIL OUTLETS ADJACENT TO SCEL POINT OF SALE. This information is included in the piece called "Odds of Our Games."

Display the Top Prizes Remaining Report: Every morning when you sign in the terminal will generate a "Top Prizes Remaining" report. Post this updated report in the clear sleeve or change mat on your counter. The clear sleeve must be $o$
The Lottery provides updated, weekly prizes remaining and end-of-game information. It is also sent out in all ticket orders. Make sure you review and display the most current
in your play station.
Scratch-off fact sheets with odds and prize information are attached to a ring on the play information, but discourage them from removing this resource.
The Scratch-off Ticket Information Sign and About Our Odds Sign must be posted at or near the point of purchase.

## BETTER U: LESSONS YOU CAN USE TO MAKE BETTER PLAYERS

The South Carolina Education Lottery invites you to explore a new initiative of ours.

BETTER U is about education Because when players know the facts, the history and the math behind our games, they'll make better choices when they play. And that makes for a better South Carolina.

We need your help teaching BETTER U's lessons to our players. So take a seat in our classroom for a course in Lottery 101.

LESSON 1: KNOW YOUR ODDS

Make it a habit of telling players where to look to find the odds of winning. Game odds are on the backs of all scratch-offs and play slips, as well as our website

LESSON 2:
EXPLAIN OUR GAMES

Take the time to explain to new players how to play our games. Let them know you are more likely to win a smaller prize than a larger one.

## LESSON 3:

 BUST THE MYTHSCorrect false statements when you hear them. If a player says playing more increases their chances of winning, let them know that's not true. It only takes one ticket to win.

## LESSON 4:

WARNING SIGNS OF PROBLEM GAMBLING

You might have grappled with what to do for a customer you suspect has a gambling problem. The BETTER U brochure in your play station is an excellent resource to share. Pass it on.

Make it your policy, and the policy of your store, to promote responsible play. And yes, if this means denying someone a lottery ticket when they've bought too many, that's o.k. Also encouraging players to set a limit or a budget for buying tickets is a good idea too.

Gambling addiction is a real, hurtful and destructive problem. If you can reach someone who is struggling, South Carolina is a better state for it. The Department of Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse Services is here to help with trained counselors available. The call is toll-free, 1-877-452-5155, and confiden tial.
