Reminders

BY STATE LAW, ODDS INFORMATION MUST BE **DISPLAYED IN ALL RETAIL OUTLETS ADJACENT TO** SCEL POINT OF SALE. This information is included in the piece called "Odds of Our Games."

Display the Top Prizes Remaining Report: Every morning when you sign on, your terminal will generate a "Top Prizes Remaining" report. Please post this updated report in the clear sleeve or the change mat placed on your counter by your MSR. The clear sleeve must be on your ticket dispenser or near the point of purchase. You can run this report at any time from your reports menu if a player requests the information.

SCEL also provides updated prizes remaining and end-of-game information on a weekly basis. This information is also sent out in all ticket orders. Please make sure you review and display the most current information in your play station.

Instant game fact sheets with odds and prize information are always available for players. MSRs attach this information to a ring on the play station. Encourage players to read the information, but discourage them from removing this resource.

The Instant Game Ticket Information Sign and About Our Odds Sign must be posted at or near the point of purchase.

Take a break from watching reruns of "Home Alone" to decorate your lottery display with holiday lights and wrapping paper. This will help draw the customer's eye to the tickets and could boost sales.

"It's a Wonderful Life," especially for customers who win prizes on tickets purchased at your location. Display claimed winning tickets around your lottery terminal to let customers know that you payout prizes and have sold winning tickets.

Let your customers know they'll have a merry little time playing the new **Gold Rush series** of instant tickets. These tickets are priced at \$1, \$2, \$5, and \$10 with top prizes ranging from \$5,000 to \$250,000.

The holidays can be exhausting for you customers. Remind them to be their very own "Elf" and gift themselves with the purchase of a lottery ticket.

You don't want to be left out in the cold. Holiday season also means it's important to keep track of your inventory. Remember to order enough product to be well stocked over holiday breaks and vacations.

SCAM ALERT: You're a mean one, Mr. Grinch!

Don't let The Grinch give your lottery players a rotten gift.

Around the holidays, reports of lottery scams sent by phone, mail, email, text message, and on social media increase. Don't let your customers become victims regardless of what time of the year it is.

In most cases, The Grinch asks for money in advance to cover processing fees to claim a phony lottery prize, but IT'S A SCAM.

If a customer approaches you with a similar tale or you suspect something isn't quite right, encourage your customer to contact the South Carolina Education Lottery toll-free at 1-866-736-9819 to report the incident during regular business hours, Monday-Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Powerball[®] and Mega Millions[®] are the games often referenced by scammers. Remember, a legitimate lottery will NEVER contact a player to ask for cash before awarding a prize.

The only upfront fee required by a legitimate lottery is the price of the ticket.

The best advice you can give your players is to NEVER give out personal information like credit card num-

bers, bank account numbers, passwords, or social security numbers to strangers. Never send money to someone promising a prize, and when in doubt, call a trusted source like the SC Lottery.
