SM Mart conducts second-chance drawings each month too. All non-winning tickets can be turned into a winner by being selected in the draw. It’s a great way to keep players engaged and coming back.

Winning tickets and winner awareness posters are displayed for all to see. It shows how often players win at SM Mart. Always cashing winning tickets up

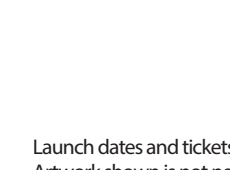

Reminders

BY STATE LAW, ODDS INFORMATION MUST BE DISPLAYED IN ALL RETAIL OUTLETS ADJACENT TO SCCEL POINT OF SALE. This information is included in the piece called "Odds of Our Games."

Display the Top Prizes Remaining Report: Every morning when you sign on, your terminal will generate a "Top Prizes Remaining" report. Please post this updated report in the clear sleeve or the change mat placed on your counter by your MSR. The clear sleeve must be on your ticket dispenser or near the point of purchase. You can run this report at any time from your reports menu if a player requests the information.

SCCEL also provides updated prizes remaining and end-of-game information on a weekly basis. This information is also sent out in all ticket orders. Please make sure you review and display the most current information in your play station.

Instant game fact sheets with odds and prize information are always available for players. MSRs attach this information to a ring on the play station. Encourage players to read the information, but discourage them from removing this resource.

The Instant Game Ticket Information Sign and About Our Odds Sign must be posted at or near the point of purchase.

Fort Mill Retailer Shares Lessons Learned

You can learn a lot from Mouine Baba.

The Lottery reached out to Baba, who runs the 7 Eleven on Hwy. 160 W. in Fort Mill, to chat after his store sold a \$1 million Powerball® ticket. Baba has been at the store for close to three years, and with help from his niece Mary Baba, has steadily grown its lottery sales. Our conversation with Baba turned into a teaching moment when he shared with us three life lessons that we think are worth sharing with you.

Lesson #1: Do the hard work.

Baba credits his relentless work ethic to growing up in Lebanon, a country where he says working hard is the standard. "You put in the effort, and you give 100 percent," Baba said. And that's how he runs his store that's open 24 hours a day. He never stands still. "I'm always jumping around to the left and to the right," he laughed.

Lesson #2: Do your homework.

Baba's makes time to study. Monica Moreira, his lottery representative, is impressed by his eagerness to learn about our new games and promotions. He'll call her with questions, so when lottery players have questions for him, he has the answers they need. "It's good to understand what you are doing, what's going on, and what's coming up," Baba said. "You need to be familiar with what's happening around you."

Lesson #3: Do it the right way.

You've likely heard the saying, "Do what is right, not what is easy." Selling lottery is challenging, but Baba focuses on three main areas. First, he keeps his ticket dispensers full. Next, he pays attention to what his customers want, and is patient with them. And finally, he provides fast service, so lottery players can get in and out and on with their day. "Even in my general life, I like to do things the way they are supposed to be done," Baba said. "I want to do it right."

His efforts were rewarded in November, when the Powerball® jackpot reached a record \$2 billion, and his store sold a ticket worth \$1 MILLION. Baba found out on social media and then his customers started coming in asking if he really sold that ticket. "I was so surprised," he said.

Today, a poster hangs in the front window of the 7 Eleven proclaiming the win, which Baba admits has given customers added confidence to come in and play. And they aren't just buying Powerball® tickets at his store, they are buying all types of lottery games.

And while Baba was hopeful the \$1 million winner was one of his regular customers, the Lottery spoke with the winner, who lives out-of-state and was visiting South Carolina when he bought the ticket.

The millionaire says it was an exciting and unbelievable feeling to check that ticket, a quick pick, and see a whole bunch of numbers match. And the real winners are his grandchildren. Grandpa is paying for their college education.

"I was just plain lucky," the winner, who wishes to remain anonymous, admitted.

And Baba feels lucky too. Before the \$1 million win, the biggest prize won at his store was for \$10,000, and that was thrilling.

"More people are coming in the store now," Baba said. "We grow day by day."
